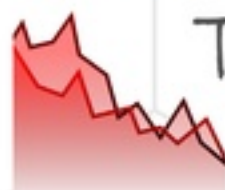
DID YOU KNOW?

WHAT TEACHING KIDS ABOUT MONEY TAUGHT ME!

A few years ago, I was asked to speak to a classroom full of students as part of Leadership Kingsport. No script, no warning—just me, a room full of kids, and a subject I knew like the back of my hand: finance. I figured I'd do my best and hope not to bore them.

To my surprise, the kids were fascinated. They were sponges, soaking up everything from compound interest to opportunity cost. And more importantly—they cared. Since that day, I've continued speaking to youth through organizations like Kiwanis, the Boys and Girls Club, Girls Inc., and even one-on-one with the children of clients and friends. Each time, the enthusiasm has been the same.

But the part that's stayed with me most? The moment when I ask kids what they'd do once they had "enough money." The answers don't focus on cars or mansions. Overwhelmingly, they say they want to make the world—or at least their community—a better place. They want to help others, start nonprofits and support causes they care about. That idealism, rooted in financial literacy, is something we could all take a cue from.

I've noticed that children often ask some of the most insightful questions. Their curiosity and open-mindedness allow them to grasp complex concepts without the same assumptions or barriers that can come with age. When I explain topics like inflation, investing, or budgeting in simple terms, they truly understand. Many of them continue the conversation long after, reaching out with updates, questions, and even sharing their financial successes. It's one of the most rewarding aspects of my career.

I'm no substitute for a full-time teacher, and I wouldn't pretend to be. But if I can spark an interest in a kid—make money and economics feel empowering instead of intimidating—then I've done something worthwhile. Whether they become entrepreneurs, artists, engineers, or anything else, understanding how money works will help them get where they want to go.
